1. **La Riva Pinot Grigio Rosé**
Italy
A dry, fresh and fruity rosé with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and cherry fruit

2. **Mi Mi Provence Rosé**
Côtes de Provence, France
The southern French coast has a reputation for being the rosé capitol of the world. These wines are not to be confused with the sweet white zinfandels of the USA. Mi Mi has a very light appearance with peachy aromas and an almost apricot palate

3. **Mr. Goose Shiraz**
Berton Vineyards, Eden Valley, Australia
A gently oaked red wine, full of blackberry, cherry and characteristic plum Shiraz notes - from Berton Vineyards

4. **Villa Rosa Merlot**
Central Valley, Chile
Very clean, charmingly ripe fruit, fleshy and easy-drinking, this restores one's faith in Chilean Merlot; it's a big step up in quality on an average 'house' Merlot

5. **Jean Gamay Noir**
Lyon, Southern France
Jean's core shows a deep intense purple colour with garnet and purple reflections. Intense aromas of ripe blackberry and blueberry, with liquorice spice and mineral notes. The mouth feel is round with a pleasant sweetness and intense fruit flavours

6. **Old True Zin Organic Zinfandel**
Puglia, Italy
American strength marries Italian elegance in this big, bold and juicy red, produced using Italian Zinfandel aged in American oak. Be daring and let this wine take you for a ride

7. **Don Placero Rioja**
Sin Crianza, Spain
Light and bright with rounded, easy drinking fruit giving a smooth and mellow wine. Perfect drop for a light luncheon

8. **Zapa Malbec**
Mendoza, Argentina
Deep garnet red colour with violet hues. Fruity aroma with hints of blackberries and plum jam, tobacco and smoke

9. **Chapoutier Côtes du Rhône**
Collection Bio
One of the icons of the Rhône Valley a superb wine with rich aromas of dark fruit, earthy minerals and spice. Soft and round on the palate with smooth tannins, rich blackberry and cherry fruit, hints of liquorice and a substantial finish

10. **Algodon Pinot Noir**
San Rafael, Mendoza
Vanilla, mocha and dark fruits fill the enticing nose. The palate is rich and fuller in style for Pinot but retains elegance. The palate is smooth with dark cherries, sandalwood and creamy vanilla flavours. This is a superbly textured Pinot Noir. The wine is aged for 14 months in French oak barriques

11. **Château de Pez, Saint St Estèphe**
Bordeaux, France
The wine has a powerful toasty nose with hints of freshly roasted coffee. The palate is strong and intense with persistent aromas of black fruit

12. **Guillermo Pinotage Painted Wolf**
Stellenbosch, South Africa
An intense fruit packed wine with a smorgasbord of red and black summer berries, savoury spice and toasty wood flavours

Italy
Cesari Amarone is extensively aged in a combination of French and Slavonian Oak barrels for a total of 3 years following fermentation in stainless steel tanks

14. Fiori di Campo Prosecco Spumante NV Organic

Fiori Prosecco is produced from organically grown Prosecco grapes (locally known as Glera) grown in the Valdobbiadene area around Treviso

15. Robinia Pinot Grigio

Pavia, Italy

This wine is lightly aromatic with ripe citrus and baked apple characters and a soft honeyed sweetness

16. Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc

Chile

This Sauvignon Blanc has a pale green colour. Intense wine with citric grapefruit notes blended with tropical aromas like mango and peach. It's a light-medium bodied wine with a good acidity, fresh style and good persistence

17. Alan Scott Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand

Whitehaven Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc captures the "essence" of Marlborough. Pure and fresh. The wine exhibits delicious grapefruit, passion fruit and gooseberry flavours with an attractive herbal note and juicy acidity

18. Mr. Goose Chardonnay Berton Vineyards, Eden Valley, Australia

Made with 100% Chardonnay this unoaked wine is refreshingly light. It has aromas of lemon, lime and honey dew melon. Flavours of sweet citrus and ripe melon that continue to a long & zesty finish

WHITES BY THE BOTTLE

19. Seasalter, Semillon Sauvignon South African

90% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Semillon. The Seasalter is wonderfully expressive on the nose and the palate with captivating notes of black current, stone fruit and green apple together with hints of fynbos and kelp, sea-breeze and a touch of oak. Rich, layered and long, this subtly powerful blend is intense but not weighty: an elegant well-balanced wine showing typical darling minerality, vibrant acidity and some leesy complexity before a saline finish

20. Lugan San Vigilio Lake Garda, Italy

This is a classic Lugana in its most traditional interpretation: delicate, floral and fruit driven with a delicate palate and lingering, fresh finish. Produced from the local grape Turbiana (a.k.a. Trebbiano di Lugana)

21. Fritz Willi Mosel Germany

This is a very typical Riesling from the Mosel characterised by a fragrant nose with a hint of honey and green apricot fruit, all of which follow through on the off-dry palate together with leesy, mineral hints. Refreshing, juicy acidity and a touch of spritz add fine balance. Very, very good and dangerously affordable!

22. Mâcon-Villages La Crochette Burgundy, France

Between the plain of the Saone River and the mountains of the Beaujolais, the Mâconnais offers a ground silica granite which is particularly favourable to the wine

23. Turckheim Tradition Gewurztraminer Alsace, France

Textbook Alsace Gewurz that demands to be matched with Asian food. The 'Cave Tradition' wines represent their standard quality range of classic Alsace varietals: the purity and finesse. Fragrant rose-petal and grapefruit aromas with a hint of sweet spice, quite rich but with lychee, spicy juicy fruit and acidity combining well to the finish

24. Langlois-Château Sancerre France

Founded in 1885 by Edouard Langlois and his wife, Jeanna Chateau, Langlois-Chateau is considered the premier winery of the Loire Valley. Now owned by Champagne Bollinger, the winery is best known for its elegant crémant de loire sparkling wines and for its still wines from the region, including Sancerre.

This well known appellation is the birth place of Sauvignon and also the best spot to grow it
